Policy on Admission of Transfer Students

Under state law, a student may withdraw from a Commonwealth charter school at any time and enroll in the school district in which the student resides. The Cambridge Public Schools will enroll and place students who have left a Commonwealth charter school in accordance with the same policies and procedures that the school district has in place for any other student enrolling in the school district, including but not limited to, examining the student's course of study and level of academic attainment when determining the student's appropriate grade placement or eligibility for high school graduation. To the same extent provided for other students enrolling in the Cambridge Public Schools, students who enroll in a school of the Cambridge Public Schools from a Commonwealth charter school shall be subject to the graduation requirements of the school district, may have certain graduation requirements waived and may be required to make up certain graduation requirements.
