30 	31 	 Hanukkah (Dec. 2-Dec. 10, 2018), also known as the Festival of Lights, is an eight-day Jewish holiday commemorating the rededication of the Holy Temple in Jerusalem. It is a happy and joyous festivity. Family and friends exchange small gifts on each of the days of Hanukkah. Christmas (always on December 25) is a Christian holiday that commemorates the birth of Jesus Christ. It is celebrated on Dec. 25. On Christmas eve (Dec 24) many Catholics attend midnight Mass. The exchange of gifts is one of the core aspects of the modern Christmas celebration and is often symbolized by a Christmas tree. Kwanzaa (always Dec. 26- Jan. 1), lasts seven days and is a cultural holiday celebrating African-American history, culture, family and community. Kwanzaa encourages African-American people to embrace their historical roots and volunteerism in their community.
